

- If the plug does not fit securely into outlet, do not force it contact a professional electrician.
- Use the plug with an extension cord only if it can be fully inserted into the cord's socket. Never alter the plug in any way.

WARNINGS

- All wires are connected; do not remove the lamp from its packaging by pulling on the power cord, as a bad connection may result.
- Do not connect electricity until the lamp is fully assembled.
- To reduce the risk of fire, electrical shock, or personal injury, always turn off and unplug lamp and allow it to cool prior to replacing light bulb.
- Do not touch bulb when fixture is turned on or look directly at lit bulb.
- Keep flammable materials away from lit bulb.
- Suitable for indoor use only.
- If the external flexible cable or cord of this luminaire is damage, it shall be exclusively replace by the manufacturer or his service agent or a similar qualified person in order to avoid a hazard.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Place the base on a flat working surface.
- Squeeze the harp inward and set into the opening of the harp saddle. And once the harp is set then remove the finial from harp.
- 3. Align and insert the shade spider ring into the threaded nipple of the harp and secure these with the finial.
- 4. Install Type A 40-W maximum bulb into the socket.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

Avoid the use of all polishers, cleaners, and abrasives, as they will damage the finish of your lamp. To remove dust or fingerprints, wipe gently with a soft, clean cloth.
